



SUMMARY
5th AVEG-FETN JOINT VIDEO CONFERENCE
13th June 2019

Referencing to The Second Joint Consultative Meeting between ASEAN Veterinary Epidemiology Group (AVEG) and ASEAN Plus Three Field Epidemiology Training Network (ASEAN+3 FETN) which was held on 7-9 February 2018 in Bangkok, Thailand, AVEG and FETN agreed to continue utilizing regular joint ASEAN+3 FETN and AVEG video conferences for information and experience sharing. Details see the report of the mentioned meeting as Annex 1.

The Fifth AVEG-FETN Joint VDO conference was held on 13th June 2019, 13:30-14:30 Bangkok time (GMT+7).

The meeting was coordinated by ASEAN Secretariat, ASEAN+3 FETN Coordinating Office (CO), technical support was provided by Ministry of Public Health, Thailand. The web conference software, "Cisco WebEx", was used as the main tool for this meeting.

Nine countries including Lao PDR (FET), Malaysia (EIP), Philippines (FETP), Singapore (FETP), Thailand (FETP), Vietnam (FETP), China (FETP), Japan (FETP and Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries) and Republic of Korea (Animal and Plant Quarantine Agency) attended this meeting. The Meeting was also attended by representatives from invited Development Partners namely Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) and WHO WPRO, World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE).

Dr. Tomoe Shimada, Coordinator of FETP Japan and Senior Researcher of National Institute of Infectious Disease – Japan, on behalf of the current Chair of ASEAN+3 FETN, officially started the meeting and welcomed all participants. The agenda was adopted by the meeting.

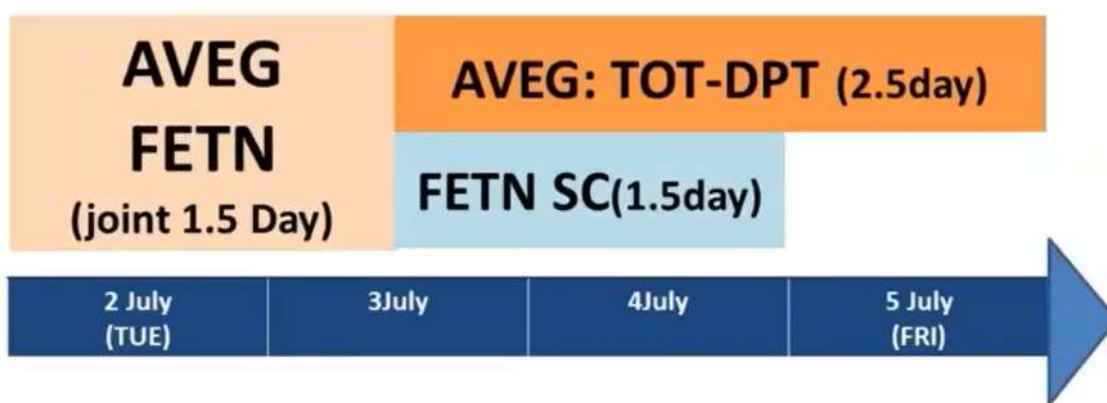
Updates on AVEG - FETN collaboration

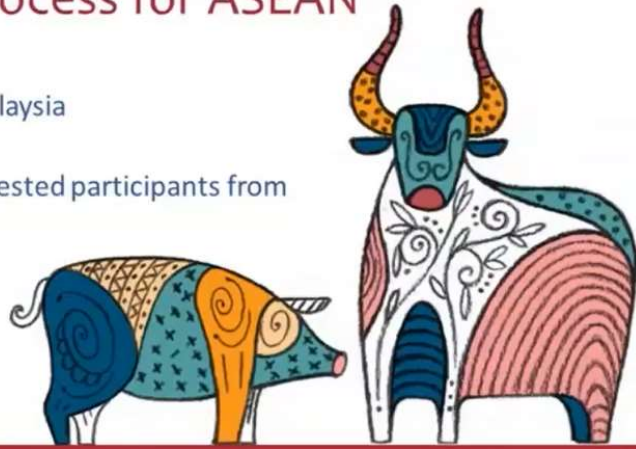
